

Burton Memorial Hall – Supplementary Booking Form Use of Hirer’s Own Equipment – Disclaimer

The Hall Management Committee acknowledges that Hirers may wish to make use of their own equipment – or equipment they have hired - when using the Hall for a private party; for example children’s toys, play equipment, books, decorations, furniture, etc.. This is permitted under the terms of hire, but all Hirers must accept that the following conditions and requirements apply;

- i. Hirers must not make use of electrical equipment, other than that provided by Burton Memorial Hall, unless it is in full, safe, working order – ideally evidenced by completion of a PAT test (Portable Appliance Testing).
- ii. All private and hired in equipment used by the Hirer during the period of hire must be in good working order and operated in accordance with the manufacturer’s/supplier’s instructions.
- iii. As noted on the Hall’s main Party booking form, no full size ‘bouncy castle’ may be used by the Hirer unless it is supplied and erected by a reputable supplier and covered by their Public Liability certificate with an indemnity limit of £5m. Small inflatable toy equipment - designed for use in a purely domestic setting - may be used. The Hirer remains fully responsible for assessing the risks of use, and for ensuring that appropriate precautions are taken.

The Hirer hereby acknowledges that Hall Management Committee and Trustees accept no responsibility, or legal liability, for any incident, accident, property damage, or injury arising from, the use of (or failure to use) any item the Hirer brings into the Hall.
